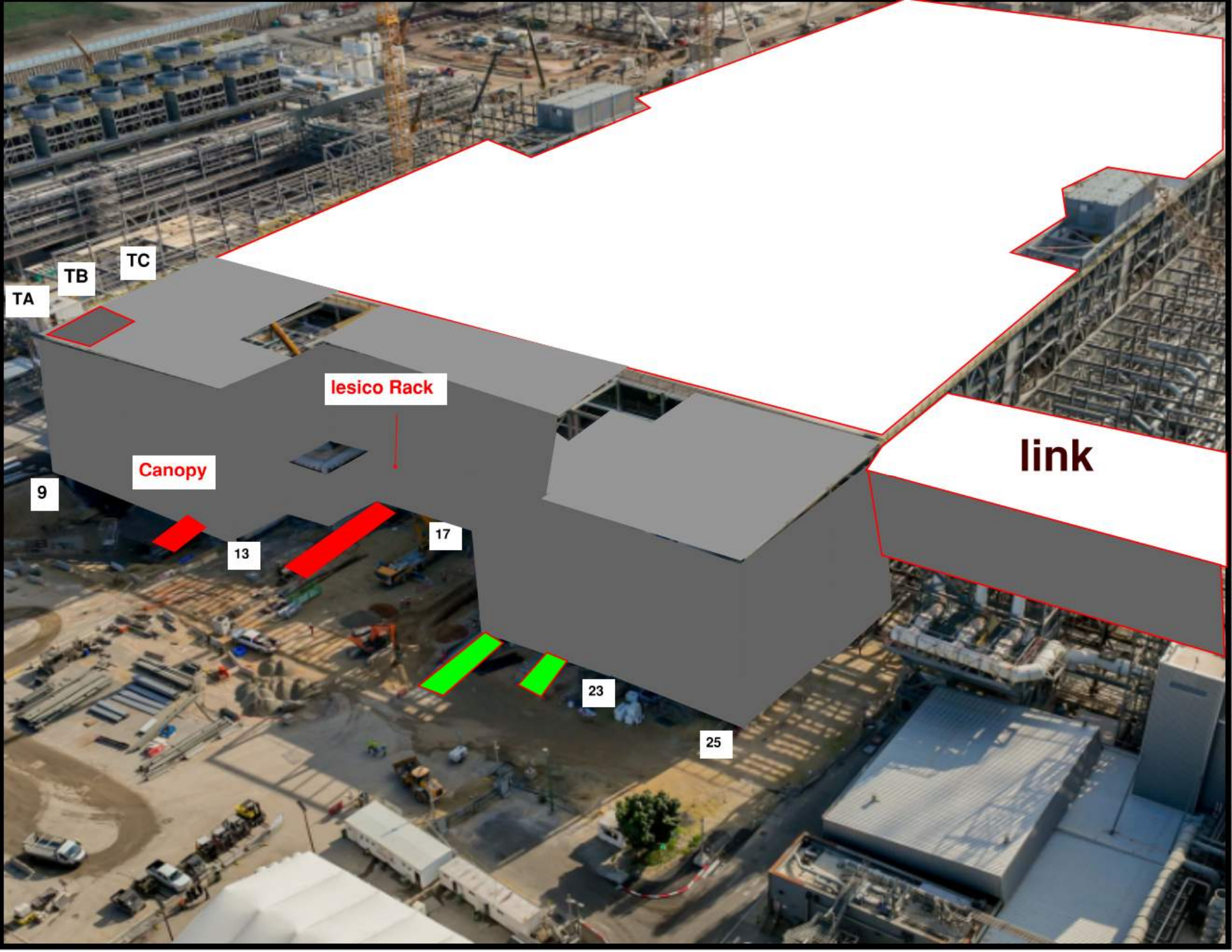


# Siding Penetration Request Form
